




Over 18 Lakhs are seriously injured in road crashes annually

Reported vs. Estimated by Sundar Committee




Social Costs for Road Accidents











5.4% of highways contribute to 53% of road accidents & 63% of fatalities






Estimated Daily Police Prosecutions	Estimated Daily Violations




Domains of Traffic Management Involves

- Health of drivers








- Not conducive to the so called traffic engineering practices
